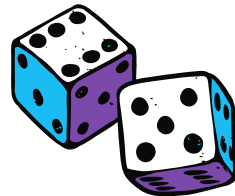
Nouns are used to name people, animals, things, places, or ideas.

Adjective

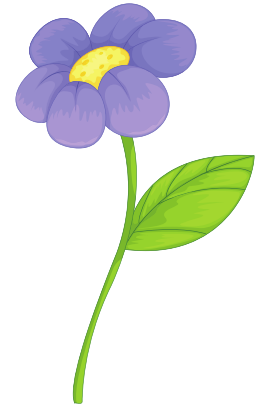
Adjectives describe nouns or pronouns.
