Party Hat



- · Party Hat template
- A4 paper (red, blue or patterened)
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Glue stick
- · Large pom pom (red, blue or white)
- · Red, blue or white trim
- · Hot glue gun
- · Sticky tape
- · Thin elastic
- · Decorative hole punch (optional)






1) First, print out the Party Hat template onto A4 paper. If you are using coloured paper, you can print the template directly onto it.



2) Carefully cut out the Party Hat template using scissors.




3) If you are using patterned paper, or paper you couldn't print directly onto, place the template onto your paper, draw around it with a pencil, then cut out using scissors.



4) Carefully, fold down the tab on the side of your party hat.





5) Loop the party hat around itself to make a cone shape and use glue to stick the tab to the inside of the hat. Leave to dry completely.




6) Using the hot glue gun, with the help of an adult, glue the trim onto the bottom rim of the party hat. Wait for the glue to dry completely.



7) Next, glue the pom pom on to the top of the party hat, using the hot glue gun. Wait for the glue to dry completely.



8) You can add more decorative pieces by gluing on pieces of paper punched with a decorative hole punch, or by adding smaller pom poms.



9) Cut the elastic to size, making sure that it is the correct length to go underneath your chin when you wear the hat (you will need about 20 cms).



10) Stick one end of the elastic to the inside rim of the party hat using a small piece of sticky tape.



11) Then stick the other end of the elastic to the opposite inside rim of the hat, using sticky tape.



12) Put on your hat and enjoy your party!
